The changes are as follows - Constitution: Article 5 Section 1A. Must hold a valid Motorcycle Endorsement or learners permit.

STATE COMMUNICATIONS

"Well it's becoming quite clear that the means of communication between friends and members has shifted altogether to Facebook. Keep in mind that not everyone who is online, has a facebook account. There are 28 chapters who've supplied me with a link to their chapter or post page for the website chapter directory. The number of events posted to the state website calendar is next to nothing and the discussion within the forum IS nothing. The chapter discussion forums on the state website will likely be deleted leaving only the necessary forums for state news, ALR initiatives and fallen rider memorials etc. The events I see shared on facebook are in the dozens and I see a lot of the events are being created within your personal pages; it may yield more visibility if you create an event within your official post or chapter page where there are likely more 'fans'; you can then 'share it' to your personal page. It may also be helpful to copy the event 'link' into the state facebook page where you'll be reaching at minimum, nearly 1,500 fans. The 911 Escort Ride ended up reaching almost 3,000 individuals through the state facebook page. Good luck with all of your events this summer."
